**This day in History:
June 21, 1864**

Grant extends the Petersburg line.

On this day, Union General [Ulysses S. Grant](#) stretches his lines further around Petersburg, [Virginia](#), accompanied by his commander-in-chief, [Abraham Lincoln](#). After six weeks of heavy fighting between his Army of the Potomac and Robert E. Lee's Army of Northern Virginia in a series of battles around Richmond, Grant chose a different strategy. The Pipestone Civil War Days Site is located north of the city on Hiawatha Avenue North and 9th Street Northeast off of Hwy 75. The city of Pipestone is located in southwestern Minnesota. The town of over 4,000 is the home of the famous Pipestone National Monument. The pipestone quarries are located within walking distance of the Civil War grounds. Pipestone's historic downtown district features over twenty buildings listed on the National Register of Historic Places. These include the Calumet Hotel, Pipestone County Museum and the Pipestone County Courthouse.
